WHAT IS SPIRITUALITY?

The Bible never uses the actual word spirituality. The closest it comes is "spiritually" and "spiritual." The word spirit is a translation of the Greek word *pneuma* which means breathing or blowing. We know that people breathe by its results, but we cannot see breath. We know that the wind blows by its results, but we cannot see the wind. Jesus explained it this way: "...no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water AND the Spirit. Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit....The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit" (John 3:5-8). Spirituality is the same. We cannot see spirituality. We know someone has it by the results. Romans 8:6 says we should "be spiritually minded" (KJV). So from this we know that spirituality has to do with the mind. What else does it have to do with? If we want to walk and talk in spiritual ways, let us speak in the language of love and walk in the same. Spirituality is sitting with a friend and telling them God loves them when they're good and bad, and will help them overcome the bad. Spirituality is going with a friend who wants to join a self-help group like Alcoholics Anonymous. It's telling them how much God will help them. Then proving it with scriptures. Spirituality is going to an enemy gossiping against you and saying God loves you both, and there's nothing they can say or do to get you to stop loving them!

That's spirituality!

Can I fall Out of Favor With God?

Mark Twain was far from being a skilled Bible scholar, but he makes us think with these words about grace: "Heaven goes by favor. If it went by merit, you would stay out and your dog would go in." Twain's words remind me of the Bible's message in Romans 3:10 and 23 — As it is written: "There is none righteous, no, not one" ... for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." And Ezekiel 18:4 and Romans 6:23a — the soul that sinneth, it shall die. .. For the wages of sin is death." The "death" in these and other passages is a reference to the eternal separation of the soul from God. This separation will occur at the final judgement and be maintained forever in the place Jesus called "hell." Hell is described by Jesus as indescribably horrible place with the "worm that does not die and the fire that shall never be quenched" (Mark 9:42 -48). The apostle John described it with the mind jarring, fear-inspiring phrase "lake of fire burning with brimstone" (Revelation 19:20; 20:10, 14 15). It is the place where all those whose names are not written in the Lamb's Book of Life will be cast. Hell is too awful and fearful to completely comprehend, along with the thought God would be just and righteous if He sent us all there.
