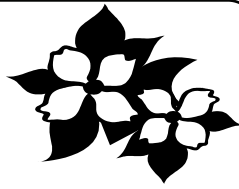

PAUL WORLEY was released from the hospital and went back to Cartmell Nursing Home.

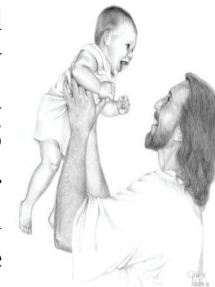
TED MISSILDINE returned home from the hospital last week also.
