**WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU DON'T
ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILDREN
TO ATTEND BIBLE CLASS**

- (1) You could see your children lose interest in coming to Bible class and worship. (Most young children love to come to class.)
- (2) Your child may never obey the gospel. (Most young people who obey the gospel do so because of what they learn in the Bible class.)
- (3) Your children who are baptized may later fall away because of a lack of Bible knowledge and commitment.
- (4) Without the proper ethics and principles taught in the Bible school, your child may one day run into trouble with the public school administrators and the police.
- (5) Worst of all, your child's soul may be lost forever.

These consequences are far more tragic than those facing parents who do not see that their children attend public school. Will your children be in Bible class on Sunday morning and Wednesday night? Just as important, will you be there with them?

Don't let you children down.
