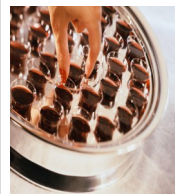

The danger lies not so much in what we want, as in wanting something simply to satisfy an unworthy desire (James 4:1-4; Psalm 66:18).
