AN ACT OF GOD?

May we pray that God will bless those who experience such great tragedies. No, God is not to blame, but the devil and his followers who strike terror in the lives of innocent people. WHY BE A MEMBER OF THE CHURCH?

Have you ever stopped to consider why you are a member of your church? In a world that is filled with religiosity, it is vitally important for us test all things and hold fast to that which is good because many false prophets have gone out into the world (1 Thessalonians 5:21-22; 1 John 4:1). With so much false teaching in our world we need to be willing to examine ourselves to be sure we are following the truth. We do not want to be surprised on the day of judgment to learn that we were following false doctrine (Matthew 7:21-23). We should always have a "thus saith the Lord" for what we believe and practice in religion and an answer for those who ask us what we believe and why we believe it (Colossians 3:17; 1 Peter 3:First, I am a member of Christ church because of what it is called. Christ is the builder of His church. He is the one who purchased the church, it just makes good sense that the church would wear His name (Acts 20:28). 15)Second, I am a member of Christ's church because of what its members are called. I want nothing more and nothing less than to be a Christian. To wear a religious name that is not found in the Bible is not only unscriptural, but it robs God of His glory. I am a member of the church of Christ because its members simply call themselves "Christians." Thirdly, I am a member of Christ church because of its creed. While many religious groups have adopted man authored articles, creeds or confessions, the church of Christ has no man-made creed. The source of authority is the Bible alone. Fourthly, I am a member of Christ church because of its worship. The church of Christ strives to give God the kind of worship He is seeking, worship that is offered in spirit and in truth (John 4:23-24). Finally, I am a member of the church of Christ because it teaches the truth about who is lost and how they can be saved. One must hear the Gospel to be saved (Romans 10), they must also believe that Jesus is the Son of God (John 8:24), be willing to repent of their sinful life (Luke 13:3), confess that Jesus is the Son of God (Romans 10:10), be baptized into Christ (Acts 2:38-47) and live faithful to Him until death (Revelation 2:10). I am a member of the church of Christ because it recognizes and teaches that no one be saved apart from the Will of God. The Crockett Rd. congregation still upholds the Truth and we will continue to do so in the future. DAN
