Note the summons of Hebrews 10:22:

- . **"Let us draw near."** That's the call to worship. The worshipper needs to be prepared.
- 2. **"With a true heart."** That's the sincerity of the worshipper. God wants the heart of the worshipper. He wants the whole heart-not just your presence, not just your voice, not just your money. He wants a sincere heart.
- 3. **"In full assurance of faith."** Come with faith, assurance, conviction. God is the rewarder of them who seek Him (Heb. 11:6).
  - Having our heart sprinkled from an evil conscience." That's humility! Come with a lowly, contrite heart! Come with a sense of need!
- **"And our bodies washed with pure water."** God calls purity of life. The baptized believer is washed in the blood of the Lamb and knows that a clean life and effective worship go together. (Romans 12: 1)

The next time you are tempted to say. "I don't get anything from the worship," read Hebrews 10:22 and ask yourself, "What do I bring to it?"




