**FOR PRAYER
RODNEY COVINGTON**

**DO YOU CORRECT YOUR
CHILDREN?**

Correction includes not only instruction, but also reproof (Prov. 6:23). There are times when the proper administration of punishment is required in order to guide the heart of a child in the direction of righteousness. A child "who gets his own way brings shame to his mother" (Prov. 29:15b). Every child will test the authority of his or her parents. If parents surrender to the will of their child, they are teaching disrespect for authority. In spite of having outgrown temper tantrums, many have never learned the importance of submitting to legitimate authority. Some parents, believing they have lovingly provided their children with the gift of freedom; have, instead, robbed them of the blessing of loving obedience—obedience to their parents and other authorities and then to God before whom we must all bow in humble obedience. The "rod" (consistent, loving discipline) must be applied to our children for the good of the family, the church, society at large, and for the benefit of our children in getting along with others and pleasing God in this life and in the life which is to come. When we read the scriptures instead of reading the psychological approaches on how to rear children, we learn the value of discipline.
